FG Primary enables your child to develop individually within a strong family and establish a vision for their future. We place particular emphasis on community spirit, mutual support and a trust-promoting environment. A smooth transition from FG Early Years (nursery and primary 1/2) with largely the same teachers and fellow pupils, as well as familiar infrastructure, makes it easier for your child to focus on lesson content.

In FG Primary,

- we will challenge and support your child **individually**
- as early as primary 3, your child will learn about **grading for key subjects, autonomous action, time management and self-organisation**
- your child will discover their **potential** and develop this with the support of a learning supervisor
- your child will work towards their **primary school certificate** in a targeted manner
- your child will learn **English** and **French** to a high level
- your child will find a foothold and **support** in the strong FG family
- your child will benefit from the **infrastructure of a grammar school** with in-house high-school-leaving exams (subject teachers, laboratories, etc.)
- your child will enjoy a **full school day** with a private playground, huge three-court sports hall and an in-house canteen

We focus on individual support during lessons. Lesson content is primarily based on the Lehrplan 21 curriculum. Focuses include the core subjects of German, mathematics and nature/people/society. Music and creative subjects round off the programme in addition to sport. Alongside English in ability-based groups from nursery level, pupils learn French as a third language from primary 3 (fifth year of school). From the fifth year, there is also a special teaching format designated "Extended learning". In this special teaching format, we tackle projects or carry out cross-subject teaching programmes. Alongside subject-based lessons, pupils work on personal assignments and projects in "Lernlandschaften" enabling them to improve their independent working and develop time management and self-organisation skills with the support of their personal supervisor.

Optional day school

If required, we can ensure continuous care from Monday to Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. A structured timetable with continuous care offers the children comfort and security. In the morning, they have time to start the day as they wish. They enjoy lunch with a carer, and after their lessons they can complete their assignments and take part in the diverse support and club programme. The guarantee of set hours of care is a particular advantage for working parents.
