In FG Early Years, your child of four and above is part of a strong family. A sense of community, mutual support and a trust-promoting environment help your child to feel secure from the very first day. From intuitive play to systematic learning, your child will come into contact with learning material in various ways and will be perfectly prepared for their subsequent schooling. The children are not divided into fixed age groups, but enjoy teaching across different class years with individual support. FG Early Years covers nursery and the first two years of primary school.

In FG Early Years,

- we support and assist your child in their individual development from **play-based to scholastic learning**
- your child feels **safe and at home** throughout the day in a nursery offering **lunch and a care programme**
- your child will learn **English** from the start in a Basel nursery that enjoys full recognition
- your child will find security and **support** in the strong FG family and an extensive house culture with diverse events and activities
- your child will benefit from the **infrastructure of a grammar school** with in-house high-school-leaving exams (subject teachers, laboratories, etc.)
- your child will enjoy a **full school day** with a private playground, huge three-court sports hall and an in-house canteen

In FG Early Years, we convey the joy of learning to children from their very first day. A smooth transition replaces an abrupt switch from nursery to school, enabling every child to make progress in learning at their own speed. The friendly and trust-promoting atmosphere combines with the school system, which is focussed on individual learning, to have a formative effect on the personal development of each child. Lesson content is primarily based on the Lehrplan 21 curriculum. The timetable includes both the core subjects of German, mathematics and nature/people/society as well as artistic design, music, and sport and exercise. Of course, we also craft using a range of materials. In addition, the children start learning English in FG Early Years.

Optional day school

Official lessons generally end at midday; twice a week they end at 3:10 p.m. If required, we can ensure continuous care Monday to Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. A structured timetable with continuous care offers the children comfort and security. In the morning, they have time to start the day as they wish. They enjoy lunch with a carer, and after their lessons, they can complete their assignments and take part in various activities. For working parents, the guarantee of set hours of care is a particular advantage.
